

Importance of Earth Day


- Earth Day allows for a day of education about environmental issues affecting our planet every year.

Present scenario of Earth

- According to studies conducted by researchers around the world, it has documented increasing amounts of temperatures at the Earth's surface as well as in the atmosphere and ocean.
- Due to extreme temperature glaciers and snow cover are shrinking, and sea ice are retreating. Seas are warming, rising, and becoming more acidic.
- Larger wildfires are occurring more frequently and more species are moving to different locations.
- The largest contributor to human-caused warming, has increased by about 40% over the industrial era. This change has intensified the natural greenhouse effect, driving an increase in global surface temperatures and other widespread changes in Earth's climate.
- Greenhouse gas emissions from human activities will continue to affect Earth's climate for decades or even centuries.

Green States in North-East India

- ◆ Mizoram: The State of Mizoram has close to 84.53% of the area covered with forest followed by Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Manipur, and Nagaland.
- ♦ Khonoma, Nagaland: This self-sustaining village in Nagaland is India's first green village. Villagers conserved the natural habitat and the community has also banned all hunting activities. This village has naturally blessed resources and it is one of the most visited places in Nagaland.
